A D V I S O R Y

"Wrong Parking" of vehicles is one of the main traffic violations committed in the twin Districts of Leh and Kargil of UT Ladakh and in view of the same a driver of Motor Vehicle shall not park his/ her vehicle:

1. a) Where parking is prohibited, Road from Doctor Chowk to J&K Bank Chowk via Axis Bank and the Road via Wine Shop/ Taxi Union Office from Doctor Chowk to J&K Bank Chowk which has been declared as "No Parking Zone" by the District Magistrate Leh vide Public Notice under endstt. No. RTO-I(T)2021(503) Dated. 13-07-2021. Parking is also prohibited on Changspa Road, Fort Road, Old Road/ P. Namgial Road which are one way roads and on Skara Road stretch etc.
- b) Similarly in Kargil Wrong parking is prohibited on road stretches like Lal Chowk to Poyen Bridge, Girls Higher Secondary School to Lal Chowk, on Hospital Road and from Circuit House to DC office Chowk Baroo and at other road stretches where paid parking has not been notified by the District Administration Kargil.
2. On main roads or one carrying high speed traffic.
3. At or near a road intersection, a curve, T point, tops of a hills & near bridges.
4. On a footpath/ pedestrian path.
5. Near a traffic light or pedestrian crossing.
6. Opposite another parked vehicle or as obstruction to another vehicle.
7. Adjacent another parked vehicle.
8. At places or roads where there is a continuous edge line or without broken line/ parking line.
9. Near a bus stop, school, hospital entrance or blocking sight/ visibility of traffic sign board or entrance of a residential/ commercial establishment or a fire hydrant.
10. On the wrong side of the road.

If a person does so, it invites penal action under the Section 201/177 of Motor Vehicles Act read with Rules of the Road Regulations 1989, which can extend up to the fine of Rs. 500/- for first offence and Rs. 1500 for subsequent offence, besides the wrong parked vehicle shall be towed and towing charges shall be recovered from the vehicle owner or person in-charge of such vehicle. Accordingly, all the vehicle owners or persons in charge of any vehicle are advised to park their vehicle in only designated parking areas to avoid towing of vehicle along with penal action.

General public/commuters are also informed that shortly we are starting "E-Sticker" challaning against wrong parking.
