Ladakh Police Honours Brave Officers with Jeevan Raksha Padak



In a ceremony today, Sub-Inspector Padma Thinles and Assistant Sub-Inspector Mohd Afzal were awarded the **Jeevan Raksha Padak (JRP)** for their exceptional bravery during a rescue operation at the Zojila Axis on April 17th, 2023.

The event was attended by dignitaries including Dr. Pawan Kotwal, IAS, Worthy Advisor to the Lieutenant Governor of UT Ladakh, Dr. SD Singh Jamwal-IPS, ADGP Ladakh Police, and Shri Sheikh Junaid, DIG-IPS Ladakh Range, honoured the officers who risked their lives to save three individuals trapped in an avalanche.

Sub-Inspector Padma Thinles and ASI Afzal courageously dug through 3-4 feet of snow with their bare hands, rescuing the trapped individuals despite the imminent danger of further avalanches. They then carried the injured from a 200-meter gorge to safety, ensuring their prompt medical treatment.

Given the conditions and the baggage of criminal charges against each, it is an obvious fact that they are susceptible to psychological issues. The Jail administration emphasize more on the maintenance and up keep of their mental wellbeing. A range of correctional measures are undertaken to create a balanced ambience in terms of serving sentences, ensuring values of human rights and reformation abreast executing the warrant of punishment etc. This is done with an aim to re-adjust them into society as a responsible citizen after their release from prisons.

In this time of agitation, frustration, disharmony and emotional stress, vipassana is a world known technique which effectively calms such state of minds to counter such defilements. In pursuits of that, District Jail Leh approached Ladakh Laddh centre at Leh for conducting Vipassana Course for the prisoners of District Jail Leh. The organization was kind enough to conduct an introductory Vipassana (Anapana) programme within the precincts of District Jail Leh by visit of Vipassana, Guru Gopal Sharam Singh. The programme was attended by the Jail staff as well. A Documentary film on Tihar Jail was also shown, depicting the positive impact of Vipassana on criminals after going through the full-fledged vipassana course that had been carried out in Jails across the country.

Total 1,325 tourists including 62 foreigners took part in this year's Chadar Trek-2023 organised by Administration of Union Territory of Ladakh.

The trek opened for trekkers in January 2023 after a break of two years, owing to pandemic.

Sub: - Driving by Underage (below 18 year driver) and Penalty Thereof.

As per the Road Accidents data analysis of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH) GOI, for the year 2016 alone, the total road accidents of underage drivers which occurred were 18,738 of which 5,383 were fatal which resulted in death of occupants/ drivers/ victims which is an alarming figure.

Taking the violation of law very seriously, new Motor Vehicle's (Amendment) Act, 2019 provides strict & harsh punishment for registered owner, parents and guardian in such cases. Under Section 199A of the Act the registered owner, parents and guardian, if their minor children/driver is caught driving motor vehicle will face three years jail term, or a fine of Rs.25,000 and the minor driver will be booked under Juvenile Justice Act, 2000. Besides, the registration of the motor vehicle used in the "commission of the offence" by the juvenile will be cancelled by the registering authority for a period of 12 months.

Therefore, keeping in view the 'serious nature of the offence' Traffic wing of Ladakh Police informs owners of registered vehicles/ parents/ guardians not to allow anyone below 18 years of age to drive a four wheeler vehicle which is prohibited and non-adherence of which shall invite strict punishment as per the law of the land.



Digilocker is a "digital locker" service operated by the Government of India that enables Indian citizens to store certain official documents on the cloud. The service is aimed towards reducing the need to carry physical documents, and is part of the government's Digital India initiative. The Digilocker platform has now the facility to pull a citizen's Driving license and Registration Certificate by way of its integration with the Ministry of Road Transport (Morth), Government of India. These digital copies available on Digilocker are mandated as original documents as per the IT Act 2000.

This is for the information of public in general and drivers in particular that Traffic Wing of Ladakh Police accepts documents of vehicles like Driving License (DL), Registration Certificate(RC), Insurance, Fitness, and any other relevant document in electronic form through **Digilocker or mPrivahan** platform as a step under the Digital India programme with a vision of pursuing transformation of India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy to make things easier for people.

However, the intant advisory does not apply to those cases where driving License (DL) or Registration Certificate have been seized/ suspended by Law Enforcement Authorities as per Motor Vehicles Act and Rules.



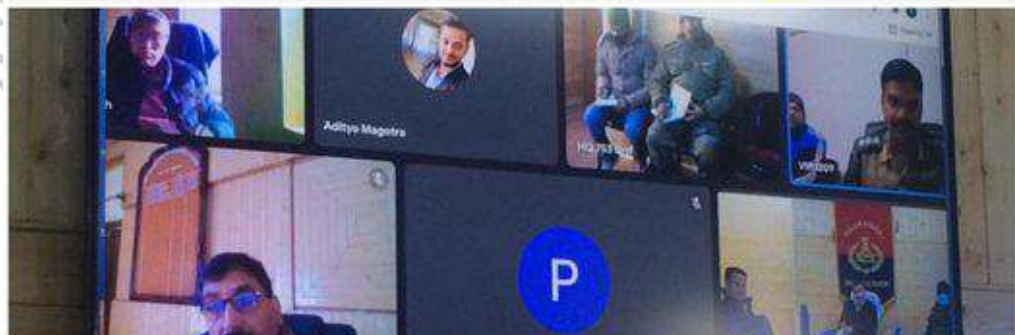
ROAD SAFETY INTERVENTIONS

- Provision of Crash Barriers on National Highways to prevent cliff rollover of vehicles in valley side of road.
- Provision of traffic calming measures like audible marking, traverse bar marking, RRPMT/ road stud induced traverse bar marking etc. on the curved sections of national highways to tackle overturning problem on National Highways.
- Provision of mandatory, regulatory and cautionary road signs on National highways and regular maintenance of signs.
- Provision of zebra crossing and necessary signs thereof, construction of user friendly footpath traffic calming at junctions are some of the improvements which should be prioritized in urban areas.
- Mandatory road safety audit of roads after regular interval of time.

NET BANKING / ATM FRAUDS



SIM Swap

Under SIM Swap, fraudsters manage to get a new SIM card issued against your registered mobile number through the mobile service provider. With the help of this new SIM card, they get One Time Password (OTP) and alerts, required for making financial transactions through your bank account.

How do fraudsters operate?

Step - 1

Fraudsters gather customer's personal information through Phishing, Vishing, Smishing or any other means.

Step - 2

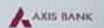
They then approach the mobile operator and get the SIM blocked. After this, they visit the mobile operator's retail outlet with the fake ID proof posing as the customer.

Step - 3

The mobile operator deactivates the genuine SIM card and issues a new one to the fraudster.

Step - 4

Fraudster then generates One Time Password (OTP) required to facilitate transactions using the stolen banking information. This OTP is received on the new SIM held by the fraudster.



How to protect yourself from fraud

- If your mobile no. has stopped working for a longer than usual period, enquire with your mobile operator to make sure you haven't fallen victim to the Scam.
- Register for SMS and Email Alerts to stay informed about the activities in your bank account.
- Regularly check your bank statements and transaction history for any irregularities.
