A. Scope of work: Design, fabrication, testing and commissioning for Bullet Proofing of one Toyota Fortuner 2.8 L 6MT SUV, vehicle of Ladakh Police for the purpose of deployments as high security vehicle for VVIP movements. The work involves fabrication, testing and commissioning of the vehicle as per the QR/specification to be intimated by Ladakh Police. (Given the security sensitivity of the subject matter, QR/Technical details (TD) shall be shared separately only with registered, authorized bidders before the technical bid evaluation thereof at PHQ, Leh Ladakh).

22. Evaluation / Criteria for selection of bidders: Two stage procedures will normally be adopted:

Stage-I:

Basic qualifications/ experiences /authorizations /licenses/QR compliances and financial credentials etc. As such tenderer must ensure that all the documents/ literatures as mentioned in the NIT/ Annexure and associated Appendices of tender documents to be enclosed in the envelop / cover containing technical bid documents.

Any shortcomings in the document thereof, the tenderer's bid may not be considered for further evaluation.

Stage -II

It includes further evaluation of bidders qualified at stage -I in terms of technical and financial evaluations through Composite Quality cum Cost Based System (CQCBS). The weight age for Technical Criteria will be 70 while Financial Criteria will be 30. The agency who quotes lowest in the financial bid shall be given 30 marks whereas markings (financial) other bidders shall be computed as below mentioned formula. The technical score for allocated 70 marks shall be computed as below mentioned criteria. Firm obtaining the maximum composite marks (i.e. Financial score+ Technical Score) shall be declared as L-1 bidder. Details are as follows:

The lowest financial offer will be the benchmark for financial evaluation and will get 30 marks and the next higher offer will be evaluated in the form of Lowest Rate X 30/ Offer Rate. The firm, which secures the highest aggregate marks, based on cumulative marks

obtained in technical bid and financial bid (after adding the scores from technical and financial evaluation) will be awarded the contract.

Note:

- a) The participating firm which shall be scoring less than 45 marks in the technical evaluation shall be summarily disqualified and shall not be considered for financial evaluation.
- b) Special condition for evaluation: The Bidder will be selected as per criteria mentioned above; however, in the event that two or more Bidders secure exactly the same Composite Score, then bidder having higher technical score shall be given the preference.

23. Bid Submission Method:

Beside below mention points, more comprehensive instructions are elucidated as **Annexure- A** which must be followed by the all bidders.

(a) Technical Bid

Technical Bid shall contain the scanned copy in PDF format of following: -

PIN-194101 within the bid submission due date & time for the tender. Scanned copy of the Tender Acceptance letter should be uploaded while submitting Technical Bid through C.P.P.Portal.

- 4) Document as per eligibility condition mentioned at clause 11 above.
- 5) Experience certificate as per experience clause 11 above.

24. Bidders are required to submit EMD as applicable, as per tender document while submitting the bids. Earnest Money should be in form of CDR/BD/DD/Fixed Deposit Receipt/Bank Guarantee from any of the nationalized / commercial banks in an acceptable form in favour of SP, Police Headquarters, Ladakh Police, Agling, UT Ladakh. PIN-194101 and should be submitted to the addressee in original before opening of the tender however scanned copy of EMD shall be uploaded while submitting technical bid. Detail's instruction thereof is at Annexure-A.

25. Guarantee/Warranty: Guarantee/Warranty of the Partial bullet proofing (Fabricated) Toyota Fortuner will be applicable as per details mentioned in QRs/specifications. However the supplier will provide a warranty for 10 years for BP material/composite material parts and 03 years for BP Glass for BP properties. As far as the visibility criteria of the BP Glass are considered, the transparency level (WLT) of BP glass should be Minimum of 70%.

Supplier shall submit a certificate from the accredited labs to the effect that the BP glass has got a minimum visibility of 70%. The firm will have to guarantee that in case the visibility of the BP glass does become less than 70% within a period of 02 years without the BP glass having suffered any visible mechanical damage, the firm will replace the BP glass free of cost. The bidder if supplying any material from any manufacturer, he should enclose original authority letter from principal manufacturer of concerned material and that material should have a guarantee of years as mentioned in the previous paragraph. The supplier shall produce all the test sheets in original that is supplied by the principal manufacturer for the relevant material used in the fabrication of partial Bullet proof. Bidders to submit a Warranty undertaking as per (Annexure-C, appendix-6)

26.Specifications/QRs: Relevant part of QRs will only be handed over to those concerned firms who fulfill the eligibility criteria as per clause 11 of TE. The relevant part of QRs will be provided on their written request on official letter signed by either head of the division or equivalent officer of the firm authorized for doing so. The letter must contain proper identification of the Company i.e. registration details etc. along with the complete information as per the format enclosed herewith as **Annexure-B (Part-I & II)**. The letter signing authority must also sign in non discloser letter to CRPF clearly stating that such QRs will only be used for their in house research in production. Un- authorized possession /circulation of same will invite legal action.

27.Right of Rejection:

- 1) Store will be accepted after inspection and only if they are found upto the standard specifications.
- 2) The decision of the ADGP Ladakh shall be final as to the quality of the store and shall be binding upon the tenderer. In case any of the stores supplied does not confirm to the specification, the same shall be rejected and risk and coast of the firm and any losses occurring to the purchaser there would be borne by the supplier.

28.Risk Purchase: In the event of the failure of the supplier to deliver or dispatch the store or provide the required services within the stipulated date/period of the supply order or in the event breach of any tremms and condition of tender, the purchaser will have the right to bet the bullet proofing of vehicle done elsewhere at the risk and cost of defaulter supplier after giving a notice to defaulting supplier. The cost as per risk purchase may be recovered from the bills pending with supplier even against any other supplies outside this contract or even from the pending bills with any other Government/ Ministry.

29.Law Governing the Contract:

- 1) The contract shall be governed by the laws in force as on date in India.
- 2) Jurisdiction of the court of Leh UT Ladakh shall have the jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of the instant contract.

30.Transfer and Sub-Letting: Tender has no right to sell, barging or sublet or otherwise dispose of the resultant contract or any part thereof, as well as to give or to let third party take benefit got advantage of the resultant contract or any part thereof.

31.Termination of the Contract: Time shall be the essence of the contract. The Ladakh Police shall have the right to terminate this contract without any notice in part or full in any of the following cases:


- 1) The delivery of the material is delayed for causes not attributed to the Force Manure after the schedule date of delivery.
- 2) The seller is declared bankrupt or become insolvent.
- 3) The delivery of the materials is delayed due to cause of force manure by more than 60 days.
- 4) In case the performance security is not furnished within 10 days from the date of issuance of supply order.
