The detailed Terms and Conditions with regard to Eligibility, Educational Qualification, Age, Physical Standards, Desired Qualifications, Mode of Recruitment, etc., are as follows:

1. Domicile Criteria:

A candidate applying for the advertised post must be a domicile of the Union Territory of Ladakh and must possess a domicile certificate issued by the competent authority in accordance with the *Ladakh Civil Service Decentralization and Recruitment – Grant of Domicile Certificate (Procedure) Rules, 2025*.

2. Essential Qualifications:

The essential educational qualification, age, and physical standards prescribed for the above-mentioned post are as follows:

S. No.	Eligibility Criteria	Remarks
i.	Essential Educational Qualification	A candidate must hold a Bachelor's degree from a recognized University. Candidates will be required to produce mark sheet, provisional certificate, etc., as proof of having acquired the prescribed qualification on or before the cut-off date fixed for filling the online application form; failing which, the candidature of such candidates shall be rejected by the Board. Candidates who are able to prove, by documentary evidence, that the result of the qualifying examination was declared on or before the cut-off date and that the candidate has been declared passed will also be

		considered to have met the educational qualification.
ii.	Age (as on 01.01.2026)	<p>Age Limit: The age limit for applying for the post is 18–28 years. However, a one-time relaxation for two (02) years has been granted to all candidates in terms of <u>Administration of Union Territory of Ladakh, Home Department Order No. 106-Home of 2024 dated 14.11.2024</u>, which is in force for a period of two (02) years from the date of issuance of the said order vide which age shall be calculated as on the 1st day of January of the year of recruitment, i.e., 01.01.2026.</p> <p>Candidates should not be below 18 years and not above 30 years of age. This means that the candidate should not be born before 01.01.1996 and should not be born after 01.01.2008 (both dates inclusive).</p>
iii.	05 years Age relaxation beyond the upper age limit for (SC/ST/ALC) Categories	<p>In accordance with the <u>para 3 of O.M. No. 15012/2/2010-Estt.(D) dated 27.03.2012 issued by DoPT</u> and the Administration of U.T. of Ladakh, GAD Addendum dated 30.06.2025 to Order No: 448-LA(GAD) of 2024 dated 27.09.2024. This means that after this age relaxation, the candidate should not be born before 01.01.1991 and should not be born after 01.01.2008 (both dates inclusive).</p>
iv.	For Ex-Servicemen (ESM) Candidates	<p>Ex-serviceman (refer to <u>DoPT Notification GSR No. 757 (E) dated 4th October 2012</u>) who has served in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from his actual age as on 01.01.2026. If the resultant age does not exceed the limit prescribed for the post by more than three (03) years, he shall be deemed to satisfy the condition regarding the age limit.</p> <p>Note: <i>Illustration for calculating age limit in respect of reservation for Ex-Servicemen (ESM): If an ESM has put in 15 years of service within the Armed Forces and is 47 years of age as on 01.01.2026; the age for the purpose of the</i></p>

reservation shall be calculated as $47 - 15 - 3 = 29$ years.

3. **Desired Qualification:**

Up to five per cent (5%) of the maximum marks of the examination shall be awarded to candidates possessing any of the following desired qualifications:

- a) Graduation in Computer Science; or
- b) Graduation in Cyber Forensics; or
- c) Graduation in Forensic Science; or
- d) Graduation in Disaster Management

Candidates can choose only one category of desired qualification. Such candidates have to appear in the desired qualification test to be conducted by the Board after the Written Examination. Further, the detailed mode and syllabus of the examination will be notified separately.

The marks for the desired qualification test shall be awarded as per the following scheme:

5. **Mode of Recruitment:**

The selection process shall consist of the following steps, in the order given below:

***Note:** Additional marks for the desired qualification and NCC Certificate shall be awarded as prescribed in the rules, subject to a maximum of 05 marks each (5% of the maximum marks of the Written Examination).

6. Scheme of Examination:

A. Physical Standard Test (PST):

Standards of physical measurement shall be as provided in *Schedule-II of the Union Territory of Ladakh Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment (Revised) Rules, 2026.*

a) For Male Candidates:

- i) Height: 162 cm (minimum)
- ii) Chest: 81 cm (unexpanded) (minimum)
- iii) Chest: 85 cm (expanded) (minimum)

b) For Female Candidates: Height: 152 cm (minimum)

Note:

- i. In addition to the Admit Card, candidates appearing for the Physical Standard Test (PST) must also bring two recent passport-size colour photographs (*the photograph should be the same as uploaded during submission of the online application form*) and one original ID proof. Acceptable Photo-ID proofs include:

- Aadhaar card/printout of e-Aadhaar,
- Voter ID card,
- Driving License,
- PAN Card,
- Passport,
- College/University ID Card,
- Employer's ID Card (Govt./PSU/Private), etc.

- ii. Candidates who do not qualify the Physical Standard Test shall be disqualified and shall not be permitted to participate in further recruitment process.

B. Physical Endurance Test (PET):

The Physical Endurance Test (PET) shall be conducted only for those candidates who qualify the Physical Standard Test (PST).

a) For Male Candidates:

- i) **Long Race:** 1600 meters in 7½ minutes (07 minutes 30 seconds)
- ii) **Long Jump:** 12 feet (3.66 meters) in three attempts
- iii) **Push-ups:** 20 (one cycle of up and down to be counted as one)

b) For Female Candidates:

- i) **Long Race:** 1200 meters in 7½ minutes (07 minutes 30 seconds)
- ii) **Long Jump:** 9 feet (2.74 meters) in three attempts
- iii) **Shot Put:** 4 kg, 14.5 feet (4.42 meters) in three attempts

Note:

- i. Any grievance or complaint during the course of the Physical Standard Test and Physical Endurance Test should be brought to the notice of the Chairman of the LPSSRB instantly on the very day before completion of the Test, and the decision of the Chairman of the LPSSRB in this regard shall be final and binding.
- ii. Candidates should appear in the Physical Standard Test and Physical Endurance Test at their own risk. The LPSSRB will not take any responsibility nor will it accept any liability for any injury, damage or any type of loss that may accrue to a candidate during the course of the Physical Test. Candidates should satisfy themselves that they are physically and mentally fit to undertake the Physical Test and submit a declaration as per **Annexure-A** before undertaking the Physical Test.
- iii. Candidates must qualify all the above tests separately.
- iv. To qualify the long race, candidates must complete the distance within the stipulated time frame as given above.
- v. Only those candidates who qualify the long race shall be eligible to attempt the long jump, followed by push-ups for male candidates and shot put for female candidates.
- vi. The PST and PET are of qualifying nature only.



C. Document Verification:

Verification of the following original documents/testimonials, along with self-attested photocopies, shall be carried out by the Board of the candidates qualifying the Physical Endurance Test (PET) on the date of the PST/PET:

- i. Academic qualification (*Graduation Certificate*)
- ii. Matriculation Certificate (*Date of Birth*)
- iii. Domicile Certificate
- iv. Category Certificate (*if applicable*)
- v. Desired Qualification Certificate (*if applicable*)
- vi. NCC Certificate (*if applicable*)
- vii. Ex-Servicemen Discharge Certificate (*if applicable*)

The scrutiny is provisional, and all documents/testimonials shall be subject to verification by the concerned Appointing Authority if the candidate is selected.

D. Written Examination:

The written examination shall be based on a Multiple-Choice Question (MCQ) paper (English/Hindi). The answer script will be OMR-based, and the maximum duration of the examination shall be 1 hour 20 minutes (*80 minutes*). The question paper shall consist of 100 questions, with each question carrying one (01) mark. There will be no negative marking. The indicative syllabus for the examination is enclosed as **Annexure-B** to this advertisement.

E. Desired Qualification Test:

The test shall be conducted only for those candidates who have claimed the desired qualification in their online application and have uploaded the requisite certificate. The test shall be held after the conduct of the Written Examination.

7. Link for Submission of Online Application:

Eligible candidates are required to fill out the online application form by visiting the official website of Ladakh Police at the designated link, viz., <https://police.ladakh.gov.in>. The date of activation of this link for submission of online application form shall be **08.06.2026**, and the last date for submission of the online application shall be **07.07.2026**. Candidates may edit their particulars in the online application form after the initial submission until the last date for submission by logging in with their registered mobile number. **However, the Date of Birth and Category fields in the application form cannot be edited after submission.** Candidates are advised to visit the official Ladakh Police website regularly for updates.

8. Application Fee:

- i) **Fee Payable:** ₹700/- (Rupees Seven Hundred) only for candidates belonging to the Unreserved and EWS Categories. For candidates belonging to SC, ST, and ALC categories, the fee payable shall be ₹600/- (Rupees Six Hundred) only.
- ii) **Mode of Payment:** The fee can be paid only online via UPI, Net Banking, or Credit/Debit Cards on the Ladakh Police Recruitment Portal (Recruitment Application Software) when submitting the online application form.
- iii) **Non-Payment of Fee:** Applications received without the prescribed fee shall not be considered valid and will be summarily rejected. No representation against such rejections shall be entertained. The fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances, nor shall it be adjusted against any other examination or selection for any reason whatsoever.
- iv) **Refund of Excess Payment:** All disputes related to the refund of excess payment, if any, shall be governed by the Ladakh Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment (Revised) Rules, 2026. Candidates are advised to apply for a refund of excess payment, if any, to the Board with documentary evidence.

9. Resolution of Tie Cases:

In cases where more than one candidate secures equal aggregate marks, the tie shall be resolved in accordance with the order of precedence given below until the tie is resolved:

- i) Date of birth, with the older candidate placed higher in merit,
- ii) Alphabetical order of the names of the candidates.

10. Misconduct/Malpractice:

If any candidate is found indulging in any irregularity, misconduct, or malpractice at any stage of the selection process, such a candidate shall be debarred from examinations conducted by the Board for such period as may be deemed appropriate. In addition to cancellation of candidature for the instant examination, any other action considered necessary and expedient shall also be taken in accordance with law.

11. Admit Card:

Admit cards for the various stages of the examination can only be downloaded from the official website of Ladakh Police.

12. Examination Centre:

There will be two centres for the recruitment process, for both PST/PET and the

written examination, namely Leh and Kargil. Candidates may choose either of the two centres. The examination centre cannot be changed after the closing date of submission of the online application form.

13. Declaration of Result:

The list of provisionally selected candidates, as per the number of vacancies advertised, category-wise, from among those who appear in the written examination, shall be prepared by the Police Recruitment Board strictly based on cumulative merit of the Written Examination, the Desired Qualification Test, and incentives for National Cadet Corps (NCC) certificates (*as applicable*).

14. Subsequent to the declaration of the final result of provisionally selected candidates, the following formalities shall be carried out by the respective controlling/appointing authority before the appointment orders are issued:

- i) **Medical Examination:** Shortlisted candidates shall be medically examined by a Board of Doctors at District Hospitals Leh and Kargil, as per the prescribed standards.
- ii) **Verification of Character and Antecedents:** Verification of the candidates' character and antecedents shall be conducted through the concerned authorities.
- iii) **Document Verification:** The genuineness of educational qualifications, SC/ST/ALC/EWS/Domicile certificates, etc., of all the shortlisted candidates shall be verified from the issuing authorities.
- iv) **In-Service Candidates:** Candidates already in Government service must furnish a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the concerned Head of Department during document verification; failure to do so shall result in the cancellation of their candidature. If a communication is received from the Head of Department withholding permission for the candidate to appear in the examination, the application shall be rejected, and his/her candidature would be cancelled.
- v) **Liability of Service:** A person appointed to the service shall be liable to serve anywhere in the Union Territory of Ladakh, or as otherwise specified by orders of the Administration of U.T. of Ladakh.

15. Important Instructions to Candidates:

a.	Before submission of online application form, candidates must carefully go through the instructions given in this advertisement notice.
b.	The candidate must write his/her name and date of birth strictly as recorded in the matriculation/secondary certificate. If any variation is observed at the time of document verification, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.

- c. Candidates are advised, in their own interest, to submit the application form well before the closing date and not wait until the last date.
- d. Candidates seeking reservation benefits must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per the eligibility prescribed in this notice. They must also be in possession of certificates in the prescribed format, issued by the competent authority.
- e. After submission of online application form, candidates must take a printout of the application form, which would be required to be produced, as and when called by the Board.
- f. In the application form, candidates are required to upload a scanned colour passport-size photograph. The photograph must be in JPG/JPEG format (upto 512 KB) in white background and not older than three months from the date of publication of this notice of examination. The image dimensions should be approximately 3.5 cm (width) × 4.5 cm (height), and the face should occupy about 60–70% of the area of the photograph with a full-face view. The photograph must be without cap and spectacles. Applications with poor-quality, miniature, blurred, or side-facing photographs shall be rejected.
- g. Candidates are required to provide their correct and active email address and mobile number in the application form, as correspondence may be made by the Board through email or SMS.
- h. Candidates are required to carry their admit card along with two recent passport-size colour photographs during the PST/PET test. In addition, they must bring a photo ID proof containing the full date of birth, as printed on the admit card, such as Aadhaar Card, printout of e-Aadhaar, Driving License, PAN Card, Passport, or any other photo-bearing ID card issued by the Central Government/Administration of U.T. of Ladakh.
- i. Admit cards for the various stages of the examination can only be downloaded from the official website of Ladakh Police.
- j. Candidates are advised to carefully opt for the examination centre. The centre of examination cannot be changed after the closing date of submission of online application form.
- k. Special attention is invited to the declaration at the end of the application form. Before accepting and signing the declaration, candidates must carefully review the application details filled in and the contents of the declaration itself. They should accept and sign it only after satisfying themselves that the information furnished by them is correct. Any concealment, misrepresentation, or mis-declaration shall lead to cancellation of candidature.

l.	Force Majeure/Postponement/Cancellation: The Board reserves the right to postpone, reschedule, or cancel the examination due to unforeseen circumstances, including natural calamities, law and order situations, or other force majeure events.
m.	Biometric mismatch/Technical Failure: In the event of biometric mismatch or technical failure during the examination process, the matter shall be handled in accordance with the prescribed protocols. The decision of the Board shall be final and binding.
n.	Data Privacy and Surveillance: Biometric data, CCTV footage, and other surveillance records collected during the recruitment process shall be used strictly for authentication, security, and examination integrity purposes, in compliance with applicable data protection laws.
o.	Duplicity: Candidates are advised to submit only one application. Duplicate applications, if found, shall be rejected, and the candidature of the candidate shall be cancelled summarily.
p.	Eligibility and Information Verification: In case it is found, at any stage of the recruitment process, that the candidate is not eligible for the post or has furnished incorrect information, his/her candidature shall be summarily rejected without any further notice. Such cases may also attract legal action.
q.	Applicability of Rules: The recruitment shall be subject to the provisions of <u>Schedule-II of the Union Territory of Ladakh Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment (Revised) Rules, 2026</u> , notified by the Administration of the Union Territory of Ladakh vide S.O. 187 dated 07 th of May, 2026, and to any standing orders issued under the provisions of the said Rules.
r.	Examination Expenses: Candidates shall be required to appear in the prescribed tests at their own expense, on the date and venue to be notified by the Ladakh Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Board.
s.	Link for Submission of Online Application: Eligible and interested candidates are required to fill out the online application form by visiting the designated link https://police.ladakh.gov.in . The date of activation of this link for Submission of Online Application is: 08.06.2026 . Candidates are advised to regularly visit the official website of Ladakh Police for updates.

16. Transparent Recruitment Process (TRP):

Ladakh Police undertakes recruitment under the Transparent Recruitment Process (TRP), a technology-driven policy. It envisages, inter alia, the conduct of the PET, PST, and written test on scientific lines with the use of:

- i) Completely automated digital machines for height and chest measurement,
- ii) RFID chip timing technology for the Long Race and laser-based Electronic Distance Measurement (EDM) technology for Long Jump and Shot Put, in the Physical Endurance Test, ensuring accuracy and tamper-proof conduct of the PET,
- iii) Biometric devices to eliminate duplication and impersonation,
- iv) Use of CCTV at various stages of recruitment, thereby maintaining a backup record and tracking activities during the process,
- v) Intelligent OMR-based written examination for automated processing and evaluation, etc.

Syllabus for the Post of Sub-Inspector, General Cadre (Executive, Armed/IRP, SDRF, Women and Border Battalion) in Ladakh Police

1. **General Intelligence and Reasoning:** This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, spatial orientation, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, Coding and Decoding, statement and conclusion, syllogistic reasoning, etc. The topics are: Semantic Analogy, Symbolic/Number Analogy, Figural Analogy, Semantic Classification, Semantic Series, Number Series, Figural Series, Problem Solving, Word Building, Coding and De-Coding, Numerical Operations, Symbolic operations, Trends, Space Orientation, Space Visualization, Venn Diagrams, Drawing inferences, Punched hole/pattern-folding and un-folding, Figural Pattern- folding and completion, Indexing, Address Matching, Date and City Matching, Classification of centre codes/roll numbers, Small and capital letters/numbers coding, Decoding and Classification, Embedded Figures, Critical Thinking, Emotional Intelligence, Social Intelligence, etc.
2. **General Knowledge and General Awareness:** Questions in this component will be aimed at testing the candidate's general awareness of the environment around them and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Polity, Indian Constitution, Scientific Research, with special emphasis on History, Art and Culture, Geography and Current Affairs of Ladakh, etc.
3. **Quantitative Aptitude:** The questions will be designed to test the ability of appropriate use of numbers and number sense of the candidate. The scope of the test will be computation of whole numbers, decimals, fractions and relationships between numbers, Percentage, Ratio and Proportion, Square roots, Averages, interest, Profit and Loss, discount, Partnership Business, mixture and Alligation and Mixture, time and distance, time and work, Basic algebraic identities of School Algebra and Elementary surds, graphs of Linear Equations, Triangles and their various centres, Congruence and similarity of triangles, Circle, its Chords, tangents, angles subtended by chords of a circle, common tangents to two or more circles, Triangle, Quadrilaterals, regular Polygons, Circle, Right Prism, Right Circular Cone, Right Circular Cylinder, Sphere, Hemispheres, Rectangular parallelepiped, Regular Right Pyramid with

triangular or square base, Trigonometric Ratios, Degree and Radian Measures, Standard Identities, Complementary angles, Heights and Distances, Histogram, Frequency polygon, Bar Diagram and Pie Chart.

4. **English Comprehension:** This component is designed to test the candidate's understanding and correct usage of English. Questions in these components will be designed to test the candidate's understanding and knowledge of English language, Vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and their correct usage, Spot the Error, Fill in the Blanks, Synonyms, Homonyms, Antonyms, Spellings/Detecting mis-spelt words, Idioms and Phrases, one word substitution, Improvement of Sentences, Active/Passive Voice of Verbs, Conversion into Direct/Indirect narration, Shuffling of sentence parts, Shuffling of Sentences in a passage, Cloze passage, Comprehension Passage.

5. **Computer Proficiency:** Computer Basics, Organization of Computers, Central Processing Unit (CPU), input/output devices, computer memory, memory organization, backup devices, PORTs, Windows Explorer, Keyboard shortcuts. Working with the Internet and E-mails: Web Browsing and Searching, Downloading and Uploading, managing an E-mail Account, e-Banking. Basics of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Generative AI Tools (including ChatGPT).
